7 SADDLES Awarded to the High Point All Around Winner in EACH AGE GROUP. (Sr. Boy, Sr. Girl, Jr. Boy, Jr. Girl, Jr/Jr Boy, Jr/Jr Girl & PeeWee) All ties will be determined by a run off.

BUCKLES Awarded to 1st place winners in each event.

MONIES 2-4 entries=1money, 5-9=2 monies, 10-14=3 monies, 15-20=4 monies, 21-29=5 monies and over 30 entries=6 monies

POINTS 1st Place=10 pts, 2nd Place=9 pts, 3rd Place=8 pts, thru 10th Place. Points will be kept within each age division: PeeWee 6 and under, Jr/Jr Boy/Girl 7-10, Jr. Boy/Girl 11 -13 and Sr. Boy/Girl 14-18. All ties decided by a run off.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All Parents/Guardians/Spectators must pay to watch the rodeo. (NO PASSES) Adults: \$3.00/ Kids: \$1.00(6-12)/5 and under FREE

1. All contestants shall comply with the rules. Any unsportsman like conduct will result in **DISQUALIFICATION**. **JUDGES WILL MAKE THE FINAL DETERMINATION.**
2. As of January 1, 2011 you must be no older than 18 years of age. (New Contestants please provide proof of age with entry form)
3. No entry form will be accepted unless **signed by Parent or Guardian**. Please enclose correct amount. Contestant numbers must be worn on back at all times or **DISQUALIFICATION** will result. Numbers can be picked up at time of check in.
4. **ALL CONTESTANTS MUST WEAR WESTERN ATTIRE.** Western boots, western trousers, western hat, long sleeve wrist length shirt with collar and cuffs. A Contestant will assess \$5 fine for losing hat during competition in the arena.
5. Drug or alcohol use by a Contestant will result in automatic **DISQUALIFICATION.**
6. Contestants name will be called three times, not present on third call; you are **DISQUALIFIED** in that event (TURNOUT). No refunds or substitutes for TURNOUTS. (Medical release at the discretion of the Arena Director and Committee.)
7. Pee Wee event contestants will be disqualified if they don't have stirrups that fit them (i.e. parent's saddles) due to safety concerns. Also, they must be able to control their horses. If the arena director thinks that the saddle and horse pose a safety issue the pee-wee contestants may be unable to participate in the mounted events. Thank you for your cooperation in making this a safe round-up.

GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

Contestants **ONLY** must address all questions or problems to the Arena Director. Parent or other interested person who gets involved with the event director, judges, or other rodeo official, runs the risk of having the person whom they are trying to assist **DISQUALIFIED**. No one allowed in the arena unless an official of the rodeo or granted by the Arena Director.

EVENT RULES

STEER DAUBING Horse must be backed into the box prior to calling for your steer. If you enter Steer Daubing you cannot enter Team Roping or Breakaway Roping.

TEAM ROPING **Confirm your partner with entry.** We will not find you a partner and both entries must be received. 1-minute time limit, three loops Partner must complete separate entry form.

DUMMY ROPING Each roper will rope for 90 seconds. Official will count legal head catches. Top 5 ropers with greatest number of catches Will return for a short go. Short Go: Each will rope again for 90 seconds to determine winner.

CALF/STEER RIDING Must ride 6 seconds to get score.

BULL RIDING AND STEER RIDING PROTECTIVE VESTS ARE MADATORY!!
